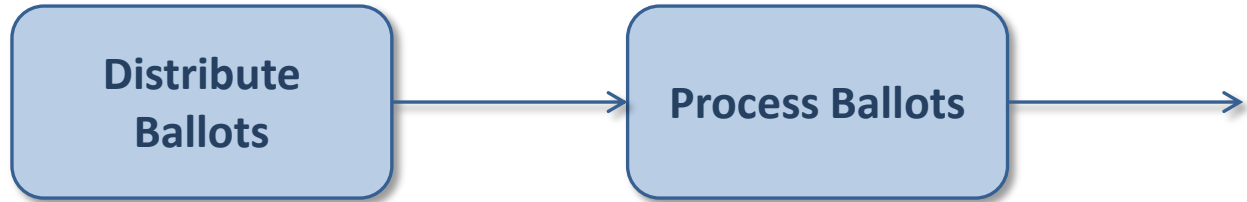


Overview

Two Quality Assurance Procedures that Boulder County Uses When Certifying Election

- Canvass/Reconciliation –an accounting of number of voters, ballot inventory, ballots voted, and vote credit assigned
- Election Audit – checks the accuracy of the machine tally of ballots

Reconciliation



Canvass Requirements

CRS 1-10-101 – Canvass Board created to:

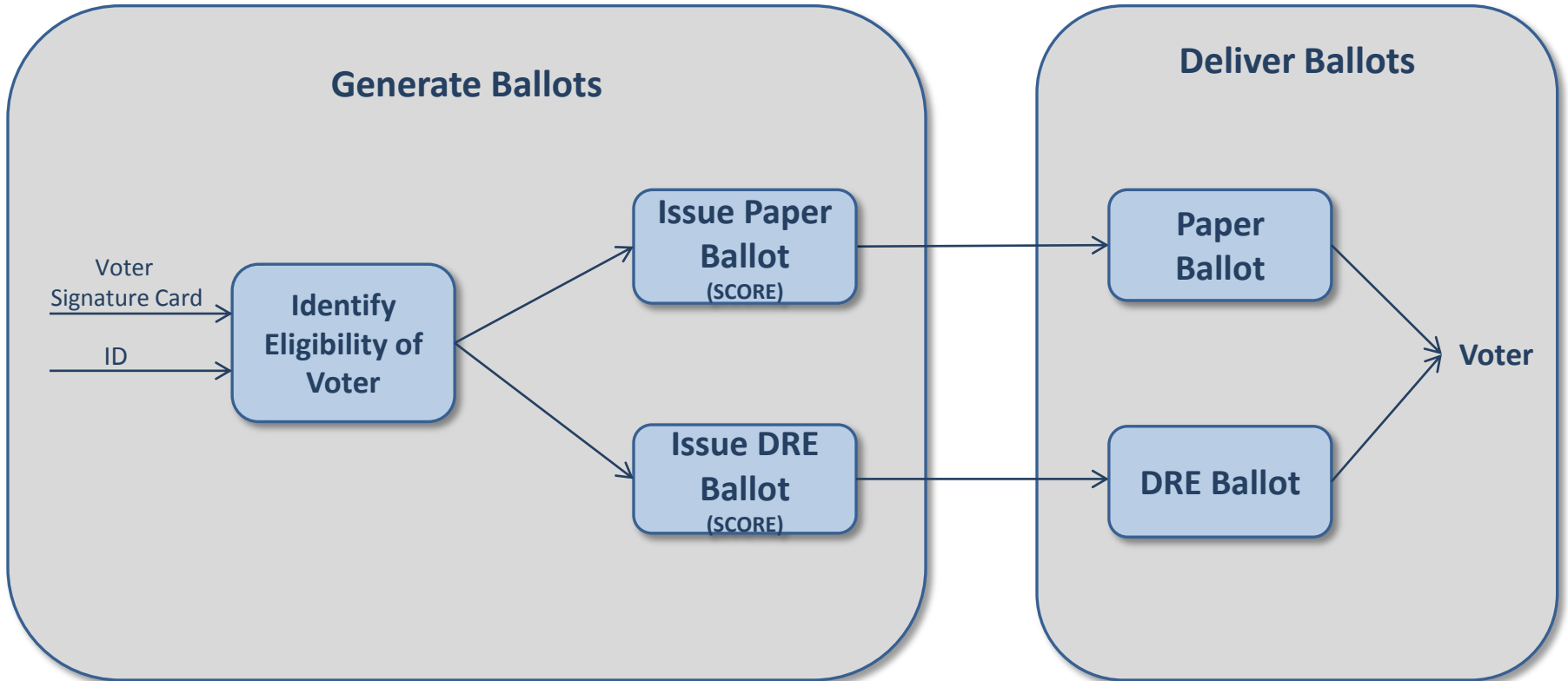
- Ensure that number of ballots cast \leq number of eligible voters (per precinct)
- Ensure that number of ballots counted \leq number of ballots cast (countywide)
- Certify the election

SOS Rule 41

- Account and balance the election and certify the official abstract of votes
- Reconcile the number of ballots counted to the number of ballots cast
- Reconcile the number of ballots cast to the number of voters who voted by reviewing the reconciled detailed ballot logs and Statement of Ballots

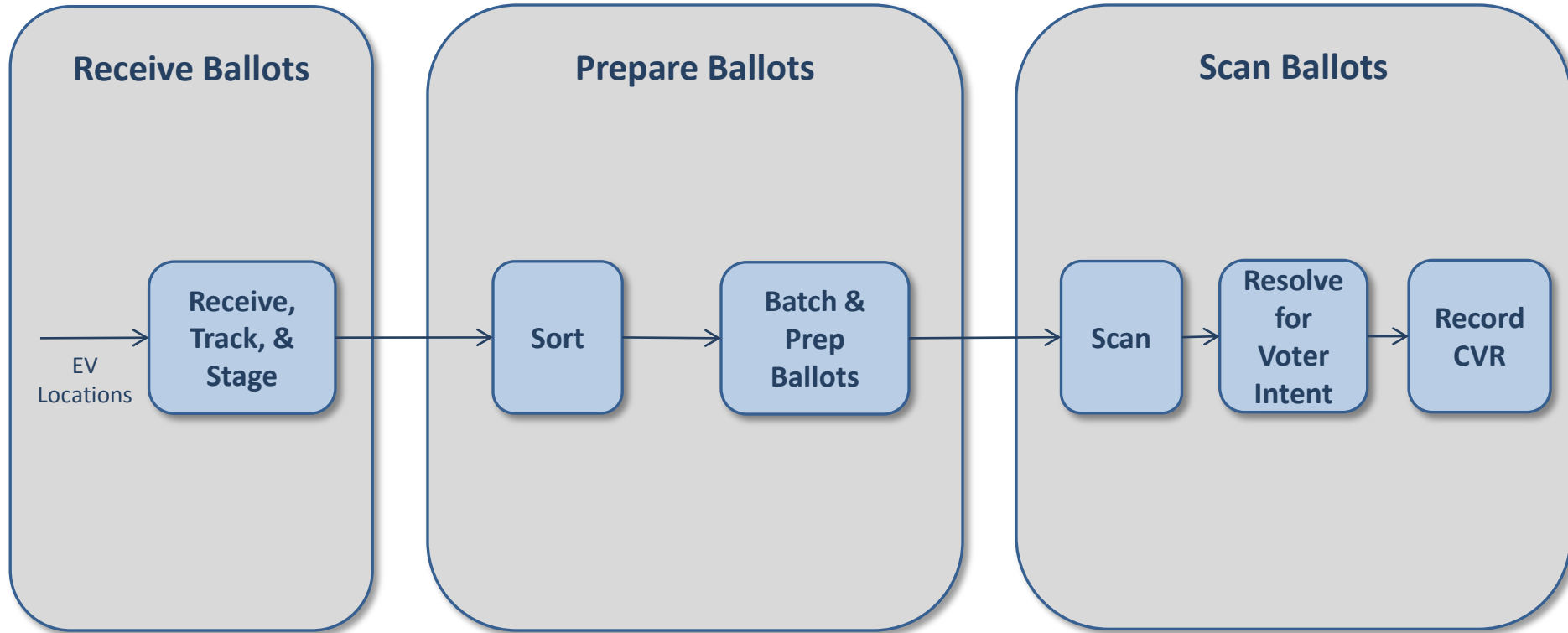

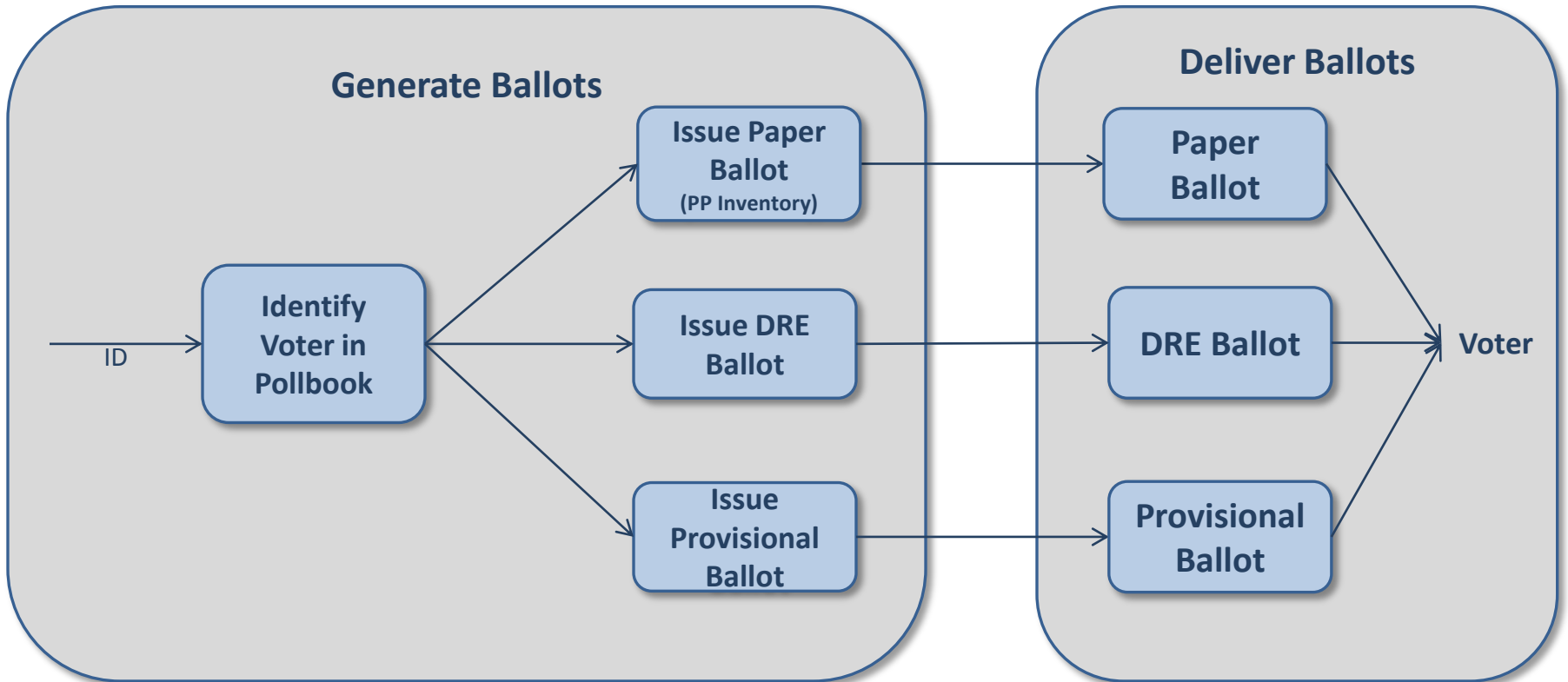

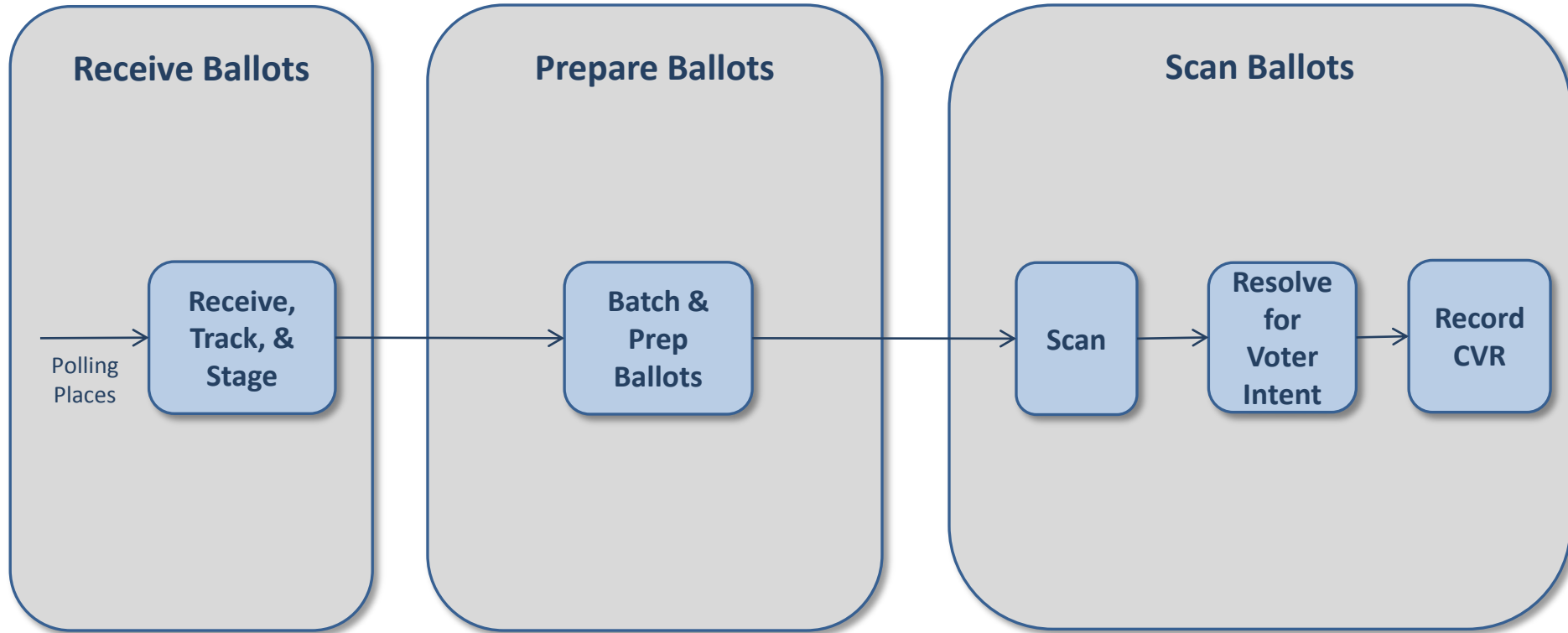

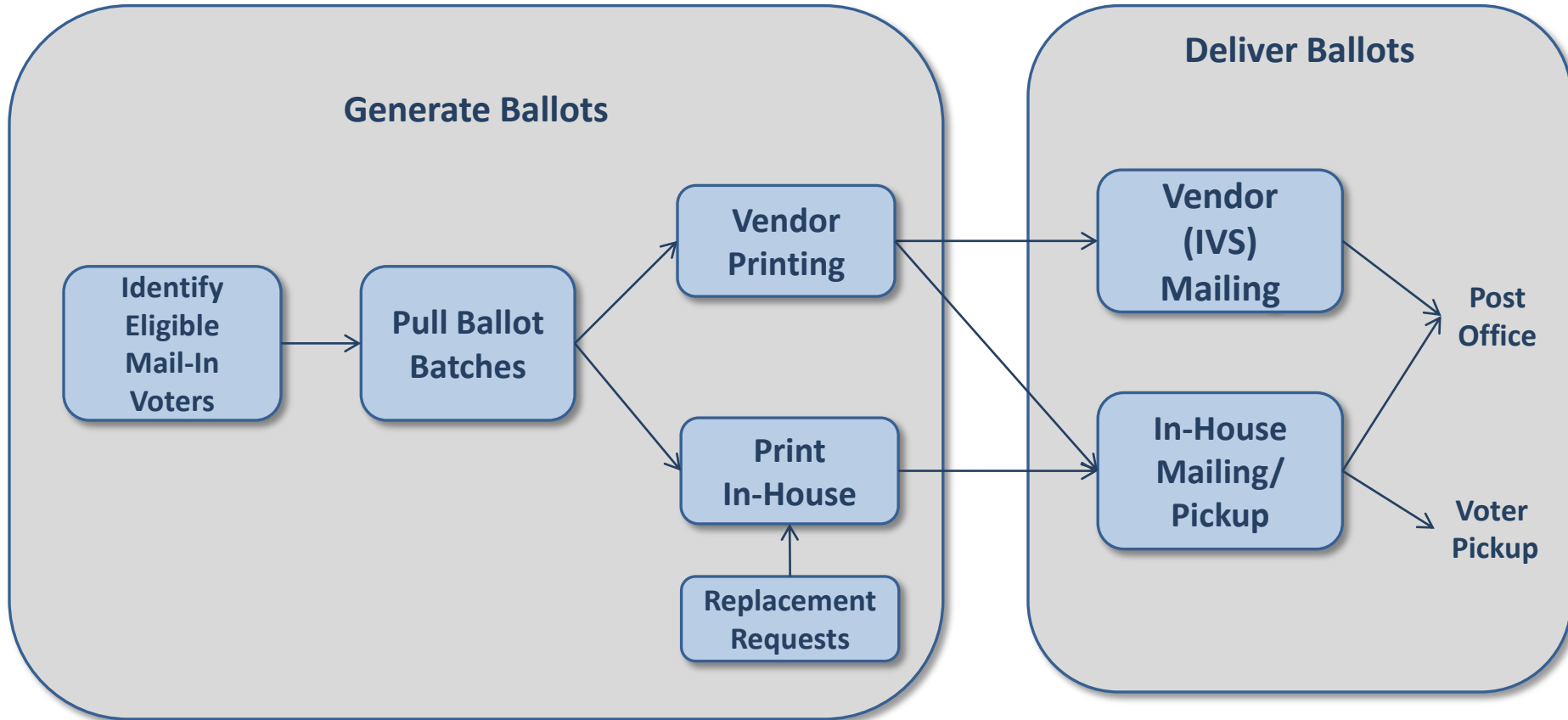

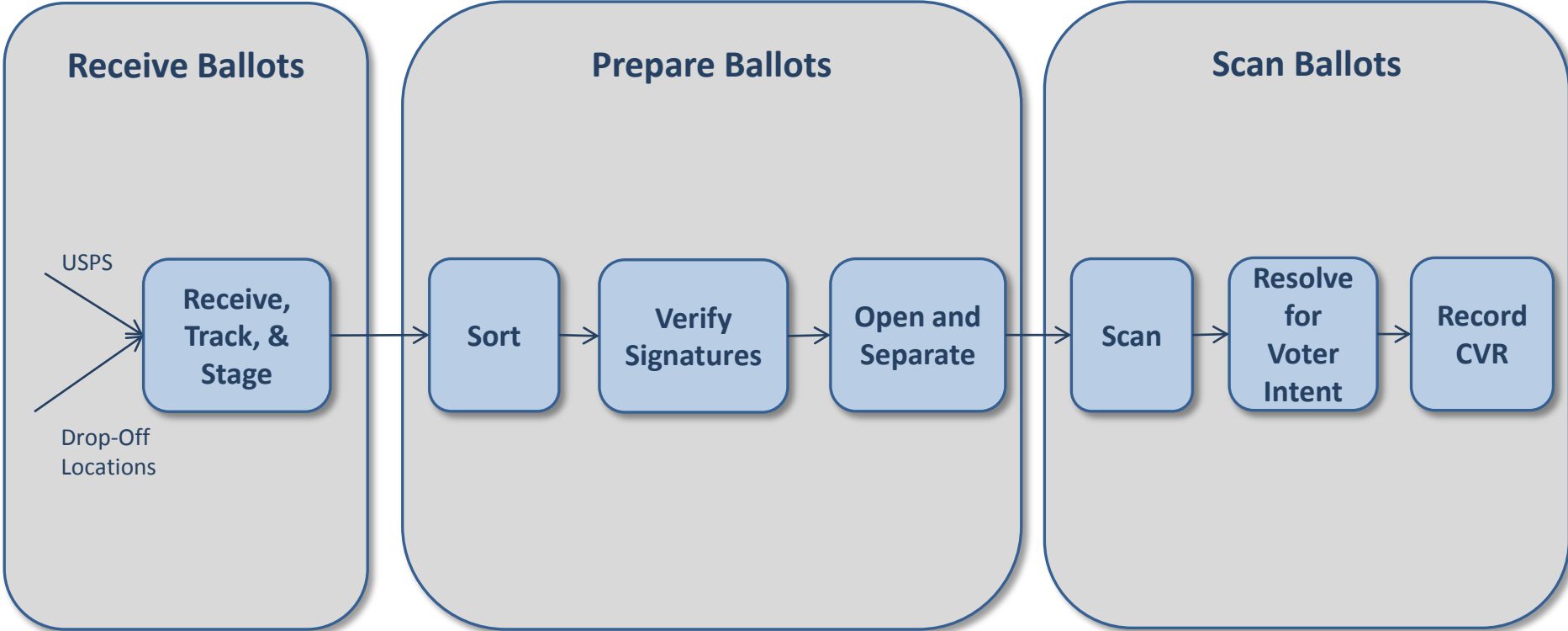
