NOTES: One can up-tune all 6 open strings half a step (1 fret) like this:

FROM: E A D G B E

TO: F A# D# G# C F Then play the easier [mostly] "open" chord shapes.

OR,: Latch a capo behind the 1st fret, and then play the generally easier open chord = shapes below (same sound either way):

Fm = Play Em shape

Eb = Play D shape

C# = Play C shape

Ab = Play G shape

Cm = Play Bm shape

C = Play B shape

Bbm= Play Am shape
